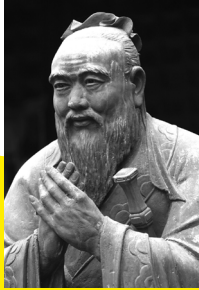

The integrated all-day school has decades of experience and established structures: The teachers do not just teach in heterogeneous learning groups; in some subjects, lessons occur in more homogeneous learning groups (courses) to cater to all learning levels. 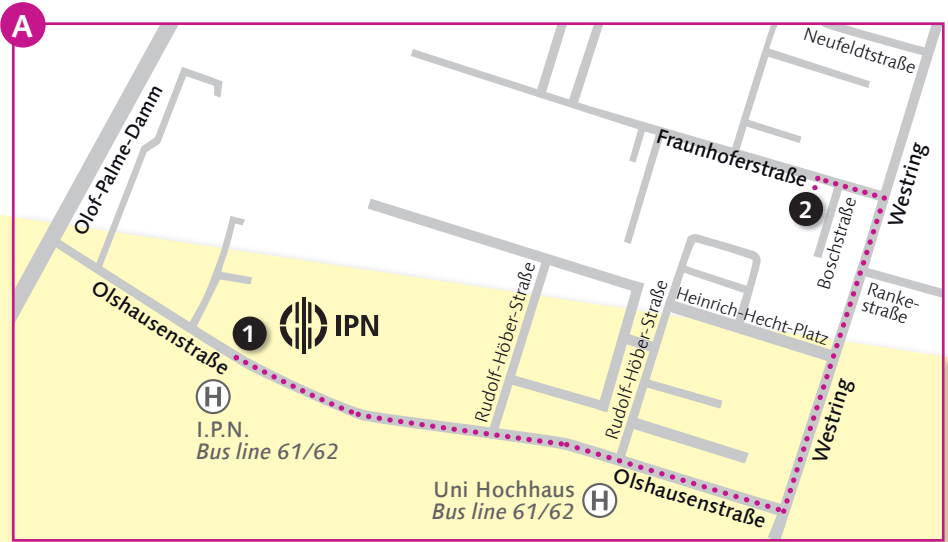

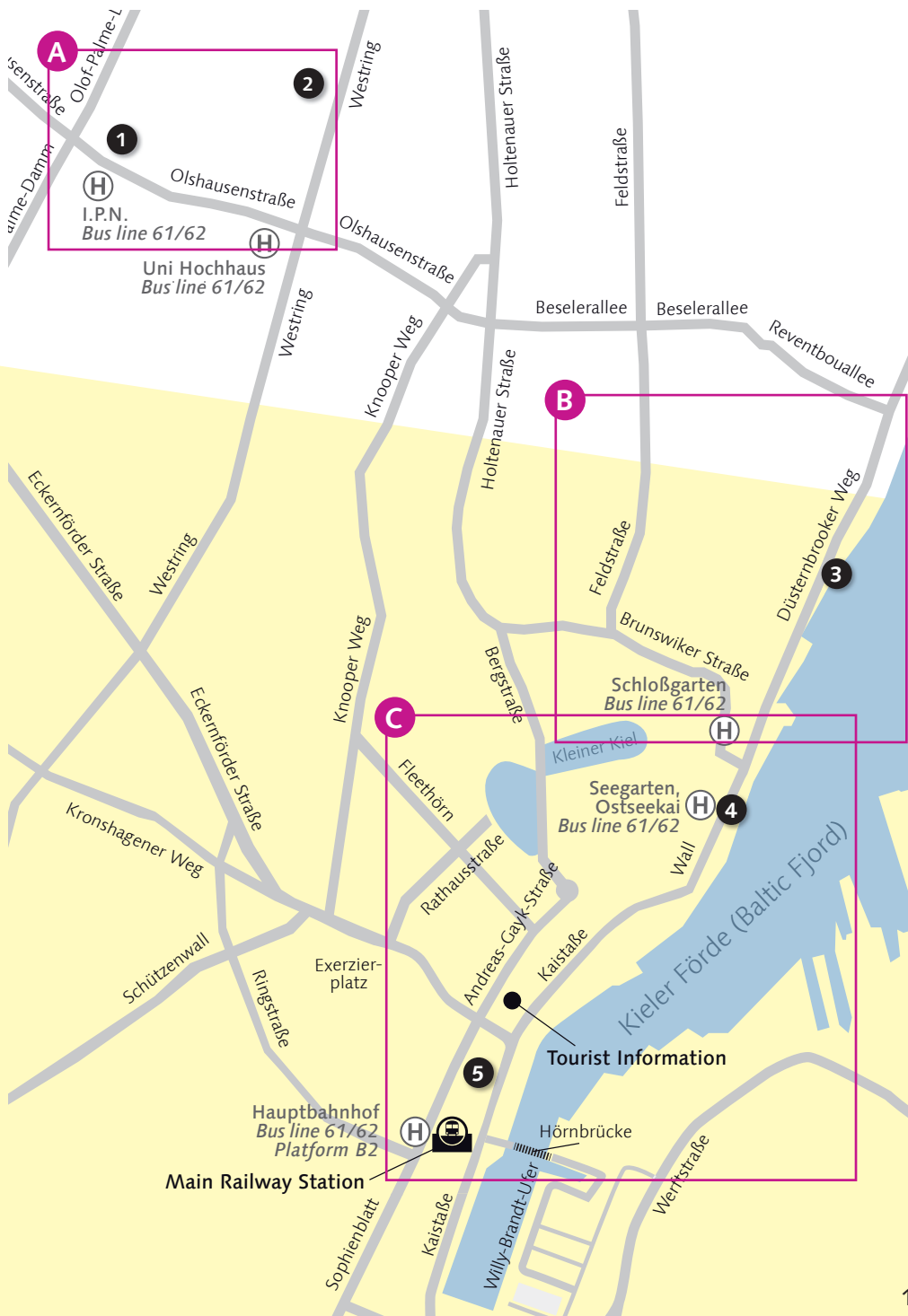

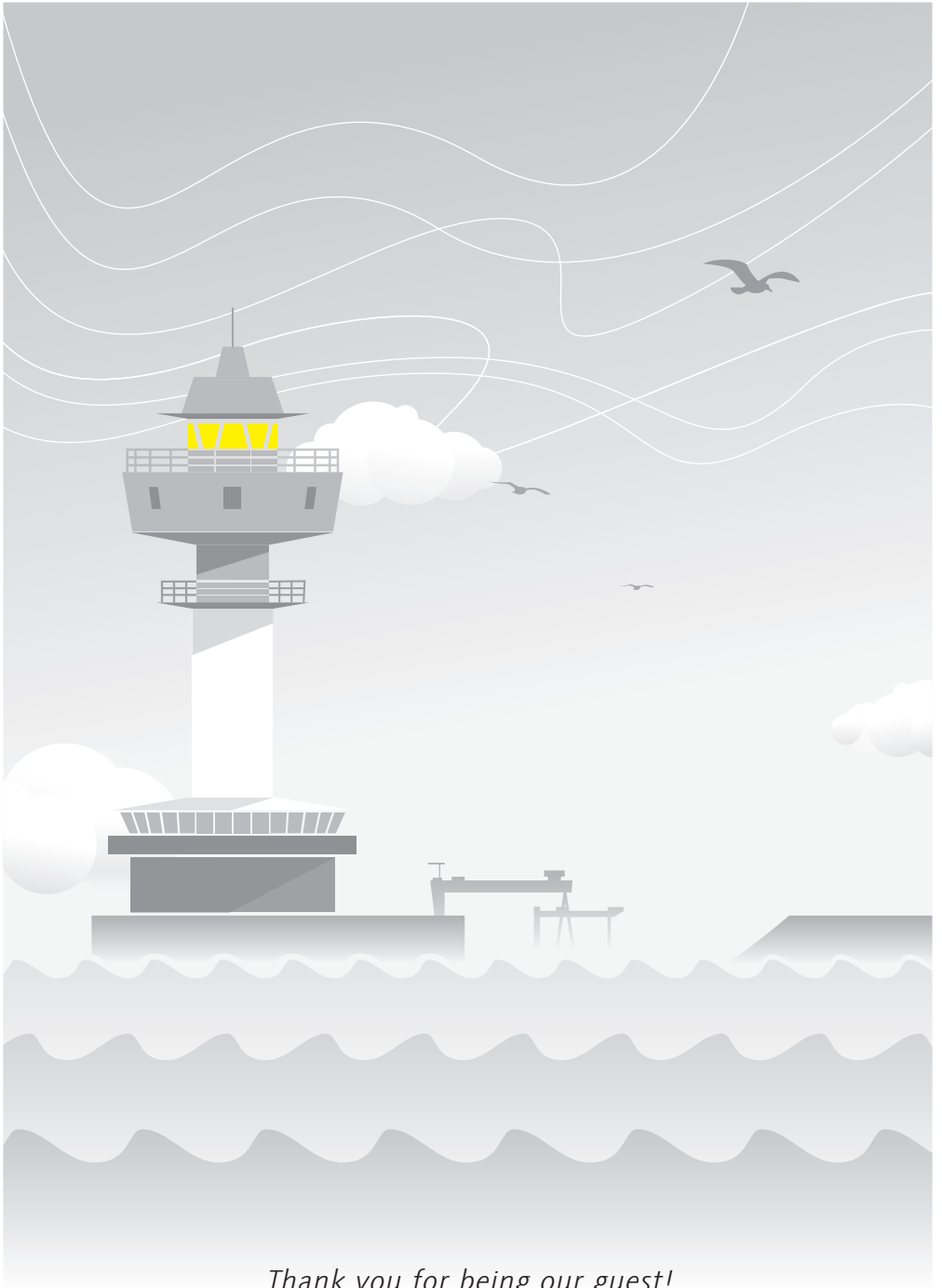
